Above all, Lord, today we pray for peace in Ukraine.

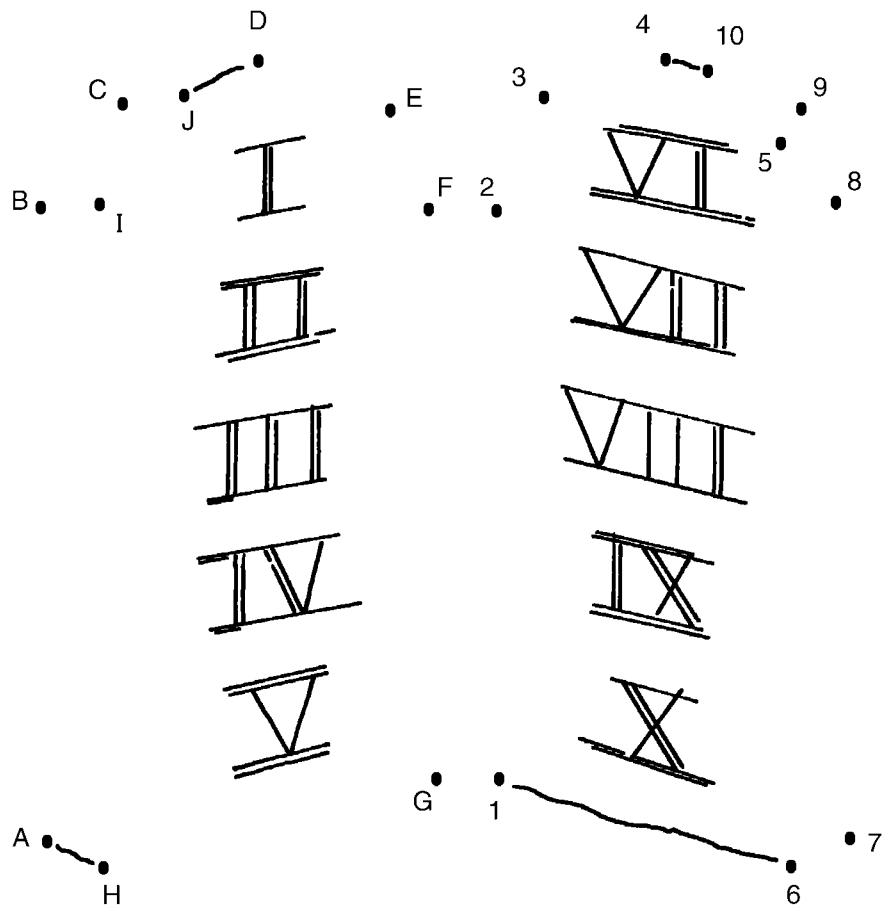
And we ask this in the name of your blessed Son.

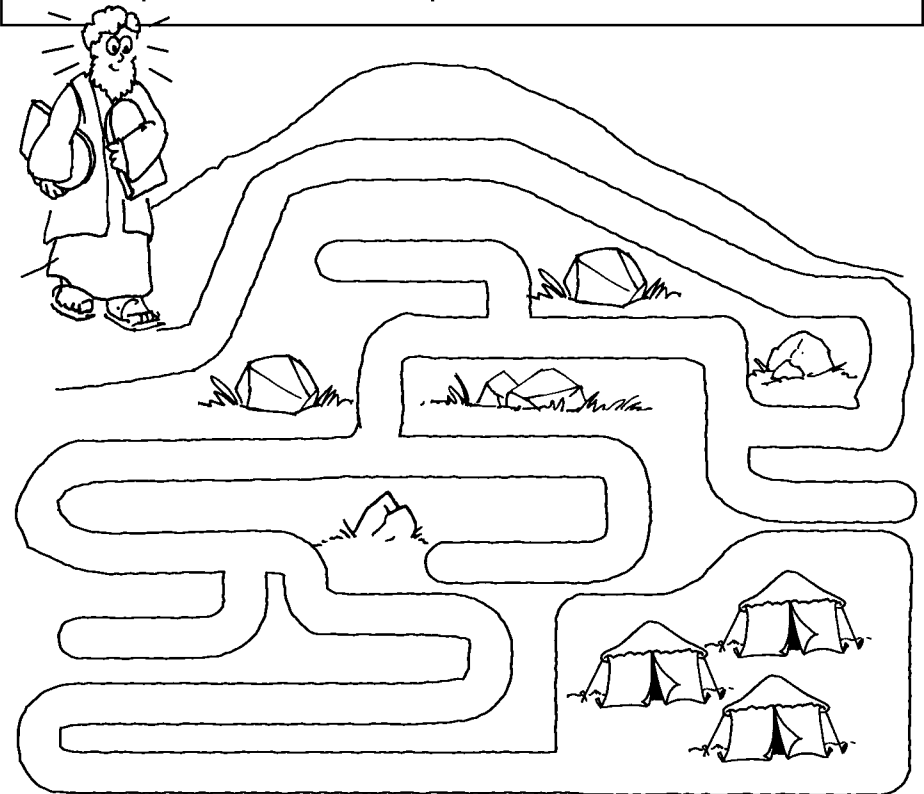

Help Moses find the path down the mountain.

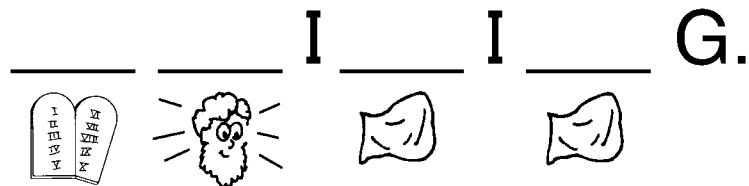
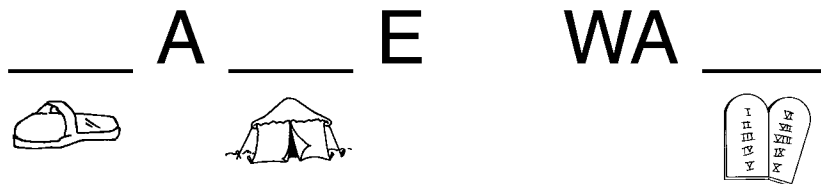
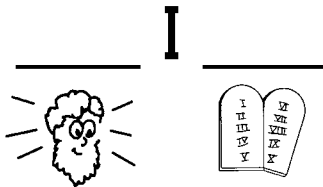
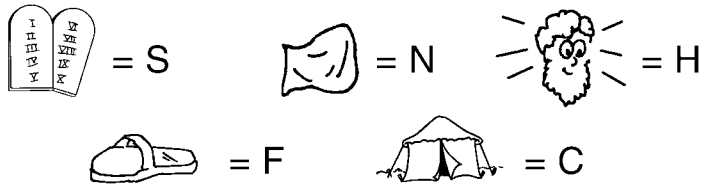
