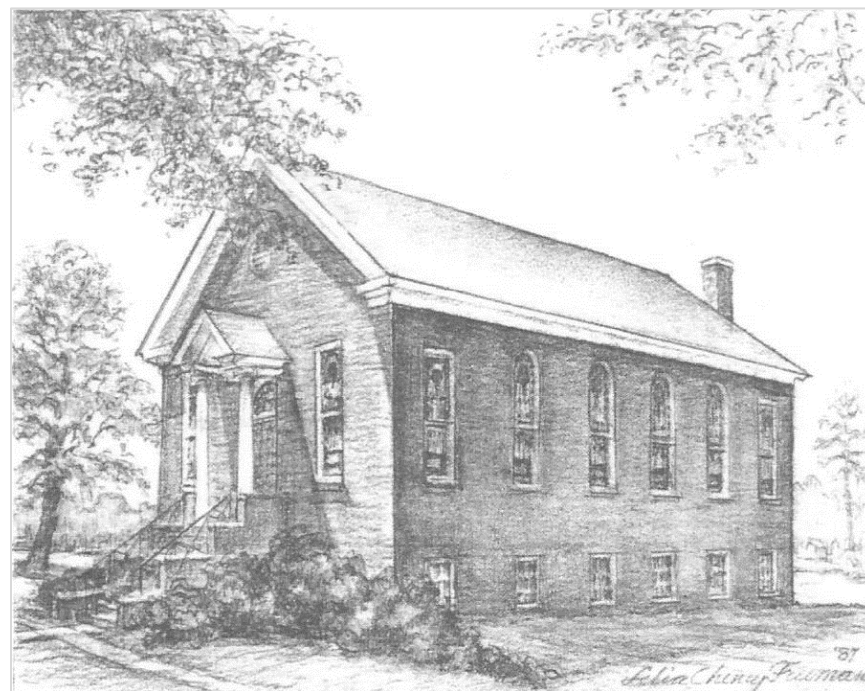

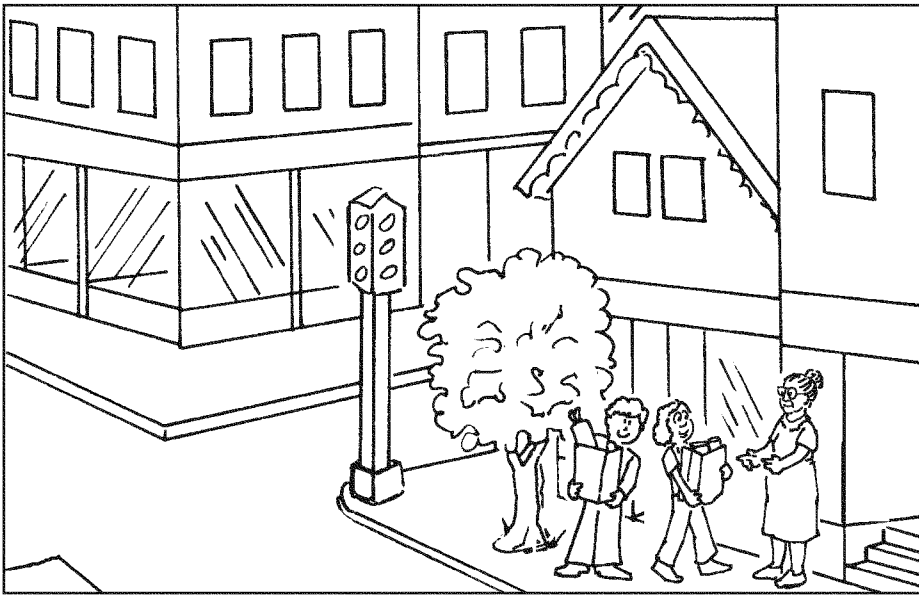

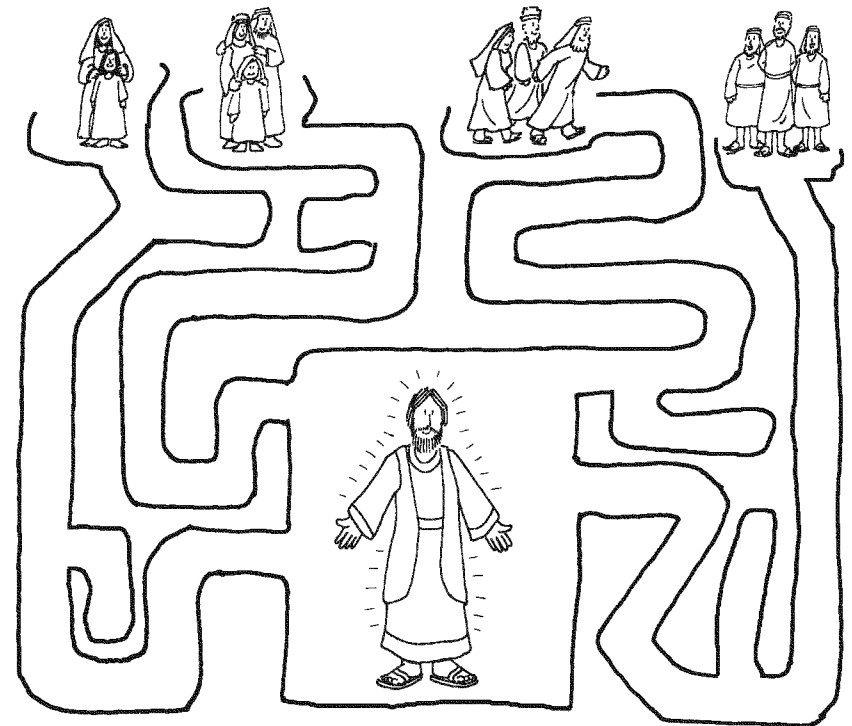

Follow the paths to Jesus.



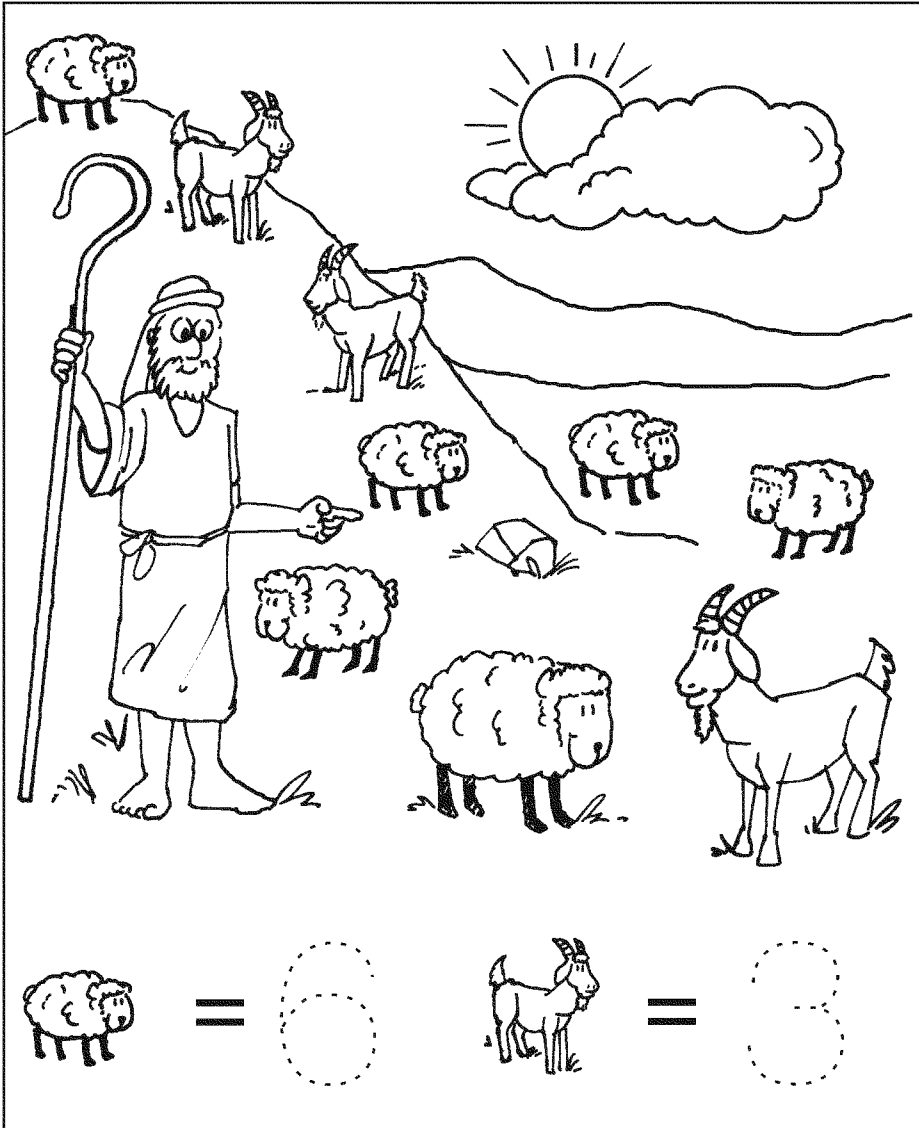

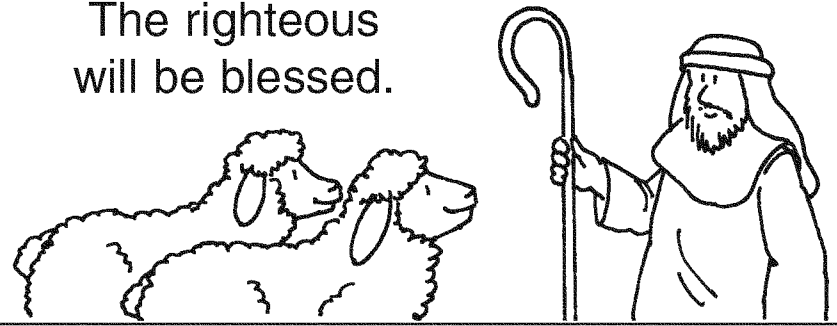
