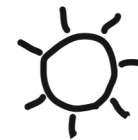

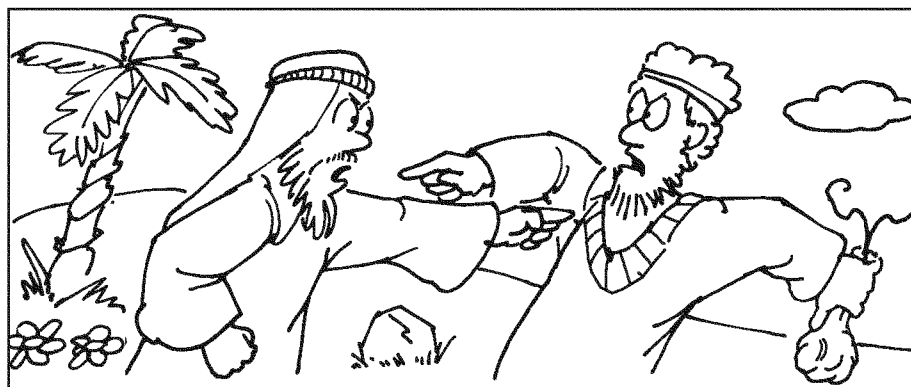
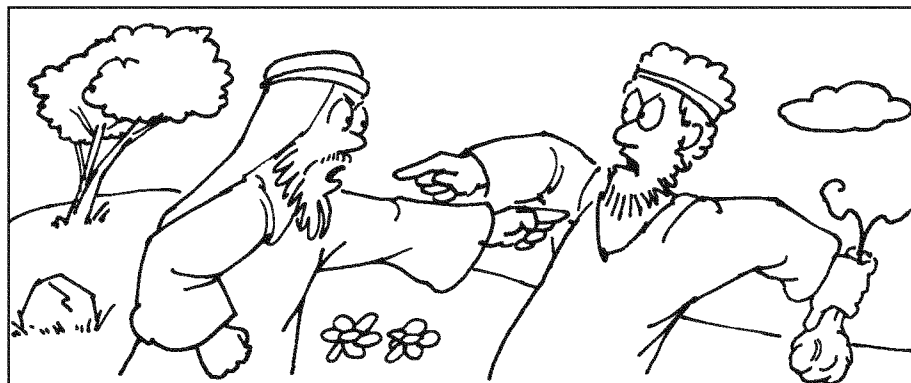

Circle 5 differences in the bottom picture.

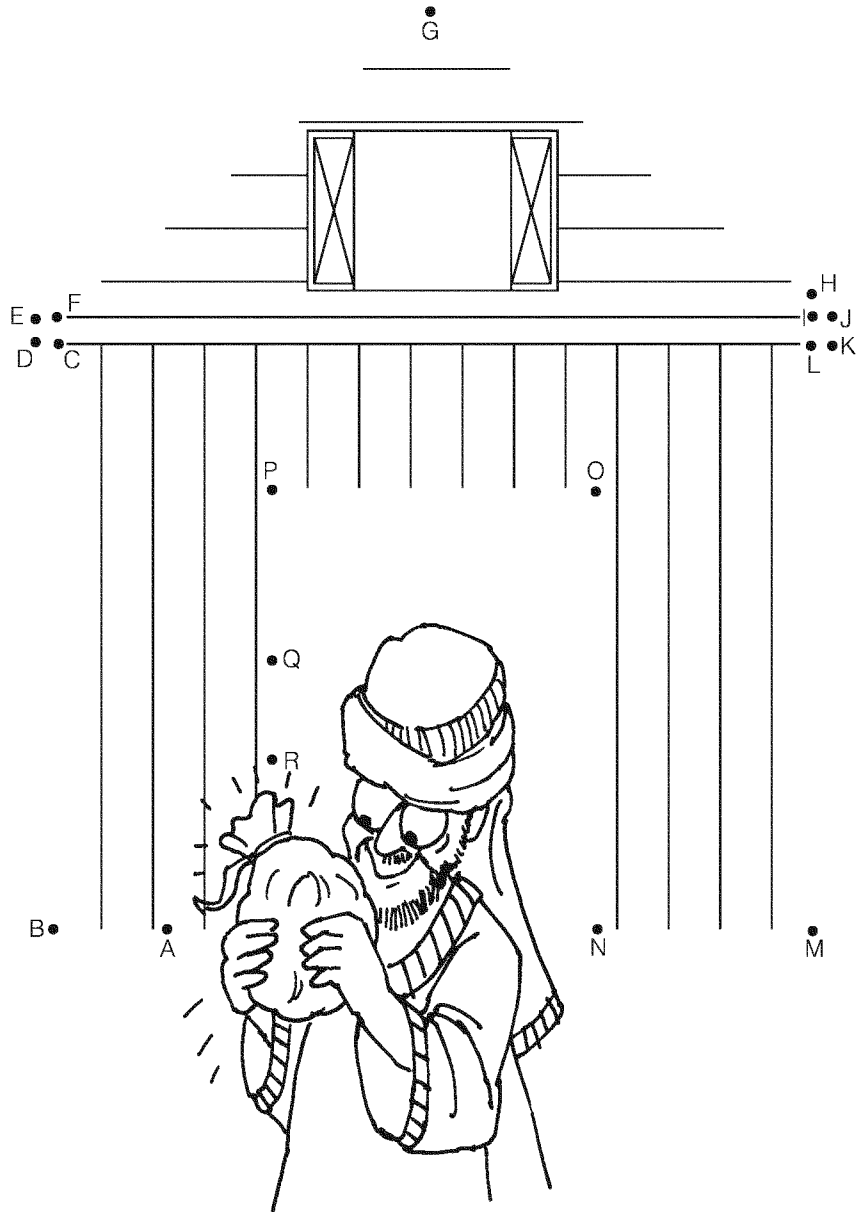
